WHEREAS the Court, acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution, Article V, Section 1, and the inherent power of this Court, in consideration of the emergency created by the impact in Lake Charles, Louisiana by Hurricane Laura and the damage to the court building did close the court beginning on August 31, 2020 and suspended all legal deadlines from that date,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, as of October 1, 2020, the court is open and filings otherwise due in this Court between August 31, 2020 and October 1, 2020, shall be considered timely if filed on or before October 8, 2020.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that parties who are unable to meet these deadlines due to the Hurricane Laura emergency may submit motions for extensions of time, supported by appropriate documentation and argument.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that to the extent prior Orders of this Court conflict herewith, this Order supersedes all previous conflicting provisions and all provisions not in conflict herewith remain in effect.
